- All exhibits must be registered or identified with the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB).
- All stallions must be in possession of a current covering certificate book issued by the IDHS (G.B). Registration/Identification numbers to be stated on the entry form.
- Classes are run under IDHS (GB) Rules. For further information please telephone 01722 714970.
- **Special:** The IDHS (GB) will award a Special Rosette to the highest placed Pure Bred in classes 254, 255 and 256.
- **Special: The Blue Chip & IDHS (GB) £2000 Challenge.** The highest placed horse (not already qualified) in classes 255 and 256 will qualify for the Final of the Blue Chip Championship, which will be held at the IDHS (GB) Breed Show on 16th September 2007 at Lincolnshire Showground. Each qualifier will receive a Rosette and a voucher for £10 from Blue Chip. In the Final, the Champion will be awarded £1000 prize money plus a Blue Chip rug; the Reserve Champion will be awarded £500, and the third to seventh placed inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, £100 prize money plus a Trophy will be awarded to the highest placed Pure Bred and a Trophy to the highest placed Under 15.2hh.

CLASS 254: ACE COMMUNICATIONS IRISH DRAUGHT PERFORMANCE HORSE, for stallions, mares and geldings, four years old and over, that are registered or identified on either the Irish Draught Registers or the Irish Draught Sport Horse Registers . Four to six year-olds to jump first, followed by seven year-olds and upwards.

CLASS 255: WELLAND VALLEY FEEDS LTD. RIDDEN IRISH DRAUGHT for stallions, mares and geldings, four years old and over, that are registered or identified on the Irish Draught Registers. Horses will be ridden by the Judge.

CLASS 256: WELLAND VALLEY FEEDS LTD. RIDDEN IRISH DRAUGHT SPORT HORSE for stallions, mares and geldings, four years old and over, that are registered or identified on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Registers. Horses will be ridden by the Judge.

- **Championship:** Rosettes are offered for the Champion and the Reserve Champion. The Exhibitors placed first and second in Classes 254 to 256 will qualify. Those eligible who do not take part may forfeit their prize money.
- **Trophy H47:** The Rutland Trophy is offered for the Champion.

- **Entry fees:** £13.
- **Special:** The IDHS (GB) offers Special Rosettes to the highest placed one, two and three year-old in classes 257 and 258.
- **Special: The NFU Mutual Irish Draught Youngstock Challenge.** The two highest placed PURE BREDS from each age group, one, two and three year-olds, from Class 257 (or, if one or both have already qualified, the horse next in line down to 3rd place only in each age group) will go forward to the Final at the IDHS(GB) Annual Breed Show at Lincoln on Saturday 15th September 2007. In the Final, there will be three corresponding Classes, each awarding £150 to the Champion and £100 to the Reserve Champion. Six horses will then go forward to the Supreme Championship – 1st Prize £150, Reserve £100.

CLASS 257: IRISH DRAUGHT YOUNGSTOCK, one, two or three year-old filly or gelding and one or two year-old colt, by an RID stallion out of a Grade 1 Mare, (RID, AID, or SID).

CLASS 258: IRISH DRAUGHT SPORT HORSE YOUNGSTOCK, one, two or three year-old filly or gelding and one or two year-old colt identified on the Grade 1 Irish Draught Sport Horse Register.
